You will complete a sponsored degree and ongoing training.


Industrial placements



Application process and entry requirements

To be considered for one of our programmes, you will:

- be on track or obtained a minimum 2:2 undergraduate degree
- have a minimum of 96 UCAS (240 old system) points from A-levels / BTEC / equivalent qualification
- achieved a grade C (or equivalent) in GCSE maths and English language
- be passionate about construction and have a drive to deliver top-quality results
- be personable and a team player with great communication skills.

Our process is simple, effective and designed to show you at your best:

- 3. Video interviews for those candidates who meet the test requirements
- 4. Final stage assessment centre including further interviews and unseen group and individual activities


