

2019 ISG Bike Ride Event Information

Name: ISG's Cycle for Charity 2019 Date: Thursday 19 September 2019

Start and finish Venue: Sonning Lane, Reading, Berkshire, RG4 6ST

Cost of entry: £50 per person (100% goes to charity) includes:

Rider pack comprising jersey

- A water bottle
- Hot breakfast on arrival (including tea or coffee and a choice of breakfast roll for all riders)
- Refreshments at pit stops on route
- Post-hospitality refreshments

Capacity: Limited spaces are on a first-come first-served basis

Distances: 40-mile and 74-mile routes

Entry fee: This year's entry fee is £50 (100% of the fee goes to the charity)

Car parking: There is sufficient, free-of-charge car parking at Reading Hockey Club for all participants. We do however encourage car-sharing where possible.

Start times: The 74-mile ride will start from 10:30 in waves of 20. The 40-mile ride will start from 12:00 in waves of 20.

Routes: The routes have been carefully planned but are subject to change. This includes on the day of the event, road closures, accidents, bad weather and other unforeseen circumstances. The final routes will be fully signposted on the day of the event. Please follow the route signage carefully.

Pit stops: Complimentary refreshments and toilets will be available at pit stops on each route, but participants are advised to bring a water bottle to refill at the stops.

There are two pit stops on the 74-mile route and one pit stop on the 40-mile route. If you have any specific energy drink or supplement requirements, please ensure you bring these with you as these are not provided.

Rider numbers: All participants will be given their own individual rider number that must be worn throughout the ride.

Helmets: A cycling helmet must always be worn during the event. Any rider without a helmet on the day will be banned from participating.

Highway Code: All participants must comply with the Highway Code.

Chipped timing: The event will be chip-timed with riders handed a timing chip at registration on the morning of the event. The chip is linked to a sensor at the start and finish of the event that will record each rider's time. Confirmation of final ride times will be available on the day.

Facilities: There are plenty of toilets at Reading Hockey Club. Changing spaces and showers will also be made available.
