Welcome

This is our first update on our progress at the Edinburgh Academy Hockey Pavilion. Construction started in September and is due for completion in February 2015.

The project

ISG are replacing the school's existing hockey pavilion with a modern, high-specification facility incorporating six changing rooms, referee's changing room and a covered terraced area for spectators. The new circa 5,400 sq ft pavilion has been sensitively designed and carefully oriented within the existing tree line on the Inverleith Place site to minimise its visual impact on surrounding properties.
